Michel Feutrie is currently Professor in Sociology of Education at the Université de Lille 1 Sciences et Technologies and General Secretary of the EUCIS-LLL Platform. He was President of the European University Continuing Education Network (EUCEN) until end of November 2010.

He has been from 1987 to 2007 Vice President of the University of Lille 1 in charge of continuing education and Director of the Continuing Education Service from 1986 to 2006. He has been appointed from 2002 to 2006 Rapporteur Général of the « Commission Nationale de la Certification Professionnelle (CNCP) », the French Agency in charge of the French National Qualification Framework and of the national "Répertoire" (RNCP) registering all French qualifications.

He has published numerous articles and edited books in the field of university continuing education, lifelong learning issues and validation of non formal and informal learning.

His main current activities and contributions are shared between three fields:

- lifelong learning: mainly on the contribution of higher education to this perspective
- validation of non formal learning: leader of numerous working groups, contributor to the regulations, pioneer in implementation in universities, national qualifications frameworks and development of methodologies in registration of qualifications.
